NEC 2002 - Power Quality Related Wiring and Grounding Changes

Speaker: Mr. Andy Cartel - Andy started his career in the electrical industry in 1948 as an Electrical Inspector with the Middle Department Association of Fire Underwriters (MDAFU), now known as the Middle Department Inspection Agency (MDIA). Through his years with MDAFU and MDIA, Andy has held the positions of Northeastern Regional Manager and Chairman of MDIA's Code and Standards Division. At the time of his retirement from MDIA in 1998, Andy served as Manager of MDIA's Philadelphia office. Andy currently serves as the Electrical Subcode Official for the Borough of Princeton (NJ) and conducts code review courses in DE, MD, NJ, NY and PA. Andy is a licensed subcode official in New Jersey and maintains numerous national Code Official Certifications. He is active in a number of industry organizations including the International Association of Electrical Inspectors, National Fire Protection Association, Underwriters Laboratories Electrical Council, Electrical Subcode Committee of the NJ Department of Community Affairs, and the New Jersey Municipal Electrical Inspectors Association among others. He also represents IAEI on the National Electrical Code Panel #12.

Program Summary - The 2002 National Electrical Code has now been approved and will soon be adopted by numerous jurisdictions. Changes in the 2002 Code in the area of Wiring and Grounding should be of interest to those involved in assuring optimal power quality performance of facilities covered by the National Electrical Code. The program will provide an update to changes in the 2002 NEC related to wiring and grounding. In addition to a hearty appetite, attendees should bring along a copy of the 2002 NEC as a reference.
