*This quarter's seminar will focus on the purchase of electrical energy in PJM territory including PA, MD, NJ and DE. The PA PUC has removed the electric rate caps for PPL customers starting 1/1/2010. It will remove the rate caps for Met-Ed and PECO customers starting 1/1/2011. Also, Section 129 legislation moves into effect in PA for energy efficiency and conservation programs.*

*Part 1 of the seminar will describe the basics of the new rules and opportunities to purchase electrical energy in Pennsylvania. This segment will be presented by Mr. Scott Helm, President of American PowerNet.*

*The second part of the program will feature Mr. Noel Chesser of EnerNOC who will describe electric energy purchase options. Mr. Chesser will also explore demand response opportunities, purchase strategies and future developments.*

**Speaker: R. Scott Helm, President, American PowerNet**
