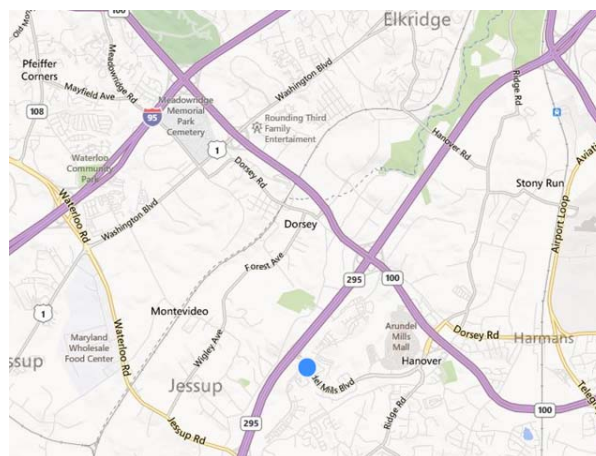

Powercon Corporation Plant Tour and Switchgear Seminar

Program Description:

Powercon Corporation is a manufacturer of Medium Voltage Metal-Clad and Metal-Enclosed Switchgear. During the plant tour and subsequent discussion session, Powercon will discuss a number of ways that Medium Voltage Switchgear and Power Quality go hand in hand. Through a look at various manufacturing techniques as well as applications using switchgear and Intelligent Electronic Devices, this group meeting hopes to provide engineers with a better understanding of the role that Switchgear plays in the Power Quality arena.

Speaker: Bob Cohn, Powercon Corporation

Bob Cohn is a Substation Switchgear Operations and Equipment expert. He is an electrical engineer with over 30 years of experience working in the utility industry. He specializes in Applications Engineering Protection and Control, and is a member of the IEEE Standards Committee currently working on the revision of the C27.23 standard. Bob has been a Powercon team member for more than 18 years. He currently manages the Powercon Field Service Operation as well as providing sales and applications engineering support at Powercon for complex projects. He speaks regularly to groups on switchgear related topics.

Note! Due to the nature of this meeting involving a plant tour, space will be limited. No walk-in registrations will be permitted. In the unfortunate situation anyone is late, the plant is located at 1551 Florida Avenue, Severn, MD however parking at the plant is limited and nearby traffic difficult at that time of the day so use of the bus transportation is highly advised.

Attendees must wear attire and footwear suitable for touring an industrial facility. For those with accessibility concerns, the plant tour will involve about 2 hours of walking and some stair climbing. Hardhats and safety glasses will be required during the tour and availability at the plant will be very limited so plan on bringing your own. Also, photography will not be permitted during the tour.

Finally, the meeting will begin with a ‘meet and greet’ at 9:00 a.m. with buses departing for the plant tour promptly by 9:45 a.m. Therefore, plan your travel anticipating this being a new location, weather and rush hour traffic conditions. Buses will return to the Hotel at around 12:15 p.m. for lunch and continuation of the seminar ending by 3:00 p.m.
