Michal is responsible to lead UL's regulatory efforts in the northeast United States serving the Eastern Section of the International Association of Electrical Inspectors (IAEI) and other industry entities. He will provide code expertise and standards-related guidance to regulatory authorities, manufacturers, designers, and contractors. Michal will also lead and actively participate in model code development efforts and support code-based advisory services solutions for UL clients and municipalities in these disciplines.*

*Prior to joining UL, Michal enjoyed a twenty-three-year career as an electrical inspector in the Philadelphia metropolitan area, with the last ten years serving as the Regional Manager for a large, multi-state inspection agency. He is a certified electrical inspector and plans examiner. Michal has been an instructor of electrical code and trade courses for thirty-four years. His work with the IAEI has led to his current positions as Secretary of the Benjamin Franklin Chapter He is the past Chairman of the Board at the International level of IAEI. Michal is very active in the code development process, writing public inputs and public comments, has served on a code-making panel, is a former member of several UL Standards Technical Panels, and is a current member of the Sustainable Energy Action Committee (SEAC).*
